Your student will then need to reapply and will be removed from the Waitlist, lottery.
 - If you refuse the spot for any reason, your student will need to re-apply, and will be removed from the Waitlist.
- If there is not an opening for this school-year, your student will be placed on the Waitlist. However, to remain on the Waitlist for the next calendar year, you will need to fill-out a form which will be sent to you via regular mail in Spring.

Academic Expectations
2017-2018**

The Sheridan Japanese School is a multi-level academically rigorous program that is designated to enable a wide range of learners to enjoy academic success. Students are encouraged to advance their learning at a rate that is challenging and rewarding for them. Scholastic and behavioral expectations are high for all students. Prior to enrollment, please make sure you have read and understand the SJS Handbook and all high school graduation requirements. The following academic policy guidelines should help clarify the performance expectations of the program.

The Sheridan Japanese School academic cycle is divided into two semesters. Multiple progress reports will be provided and a final report will be provided at the end of the semester to show an assessment of the student's progress and level of content mastery. In content based subject areas, students will receive one of four possible letter grades.

- **A** This grade indicated advanced mastery of the subject at the appropriate level for the student. In addition to required work sample folder items, the student will have completed and turned in all required assignments and maintained a cumulative average of 90% or better for the semester.
- **B** This grade indicates initial mastery of the subject at the appropriate level for the student. In addition to required work sample folder items, the student will have completed and turned in most of the required assignments and maintained a cumulative average of 80% or better for the semester.
- **C** This grade indicated satisfactory progress toward mastery of the subject at the appropriate level for the student. In addition to required work sample folder items, the student will have completed and turned in most of the required assignments and maintained a cumulative average of 70% or better for the semester.
- **F** This grade indicates that the student's work is unsatisfactory at the end of the grading period. If such a grade is given for a midterm progress report, every effort will be made by staff to help the student meet expectations and be academically successful. Friday afternoon work sessions will also be provided, and parents are highly encouraged to set up a conference early in the semester to discuss possible ways to help at home as well. Parents of high school students should note that a final grade of "F" earns zero credit toward graduation. Parents of fourth through eighth grade students must understand that, after having received two (2) final grades of "F" in any one school year, the student may not be promoted to the next grade the following school year.
